How to separate and dispose of recyclable resources and garbage, **Preservation Booklet**

There are basic rules for garbage disposal.

Separate it properly.

There are many things in the garbage that can be still used as resources. Let's use limited recyclable resources effectively by separating them properly.

Put it in the designated garbage bag.

Garbage that are not in the Toyota City's designated garbage bags will not be collected. Make sure to use designated garbage bag (ref P.1).

Designated garbage bags are sold at Cleaning Service Division (within the site of Togari Cleaning Center), supermarkets within Toyota City, pharmacy (drug stores), convenience stores, etc.

By 8:30 a.m. on the designated date

Garbage are collected from 8:30 a.m. to about 4 p.m. on collection days. Regardless of the collection time, please make sure to take out your trashes by 8:30 a.m. on the collection day.

Please follow the instructions from your apartment manager or Neighborhood Association regarding the garbage disposal days and limit hours.

To the designated place

Separate garbage and recyclable resource stations are managed by the Neighborhood Association or management company. Each region may have their own garbage disposal rules, please be sure to follow those rules.



※There are garbage collection on Mon. to Fri. available on holidays as well. (Exclude Year-End New Year Holidays) ※You can check garbage collection days of Year-End New Year Holidays schedule on Toyota City Hall official website or on [さんあ~る: SAN A-RU] App. Scan QR code to install app.

※Garbage from business premises/offices cannot be disposed at city garbage collection stations.

What to collect at the recyclable resource station

Location: recyclable resource station or recycle station Every month th & th XXXday Reference P.13

How to dispose: put garbage in the box directly *There are no designated garbage bag for this.

Glass products (beverage bottles/ cosmetic bottles), beverage cans, pet bottles, Hazardous waste (fluorescent lamps, battery, mobile battery, non-removable rechargeable batteries, small size rechargeable appliances (less than 30cm on one side etc.) Dangerous waste (lighter, spray can, etc.)



Collected items at recycle station

It is permanent recyclable waste collection site (only closed on Year-End New Year holidays). No designated garbage bag. Put garbage in to the box directly.

Collected items at recyclable resource station (reference in the above), recycled papers (newspaper, magazines, miscellaneous recyclable paper, cardboard, carton packs such as milk or juice cartons), old cloths (used clothes, etc.), and plastic containers & packaging.

How to take out composite products

When separating composite products made of different materials, please sort out with a larger proportion. Regarding composition of metal and plastic products put out on **Metal garbage** day.

Paper and cloth products that cannot be recycled

Tissue paper, kitchen paper, coated paper cup, receipts which used of special paper, shredded paper which is smaller size than name business card.





Check page 13 about recyclable papers.

Rubber products

Rubber products such as tire of bicycle (only rubber parts), sneaker, long boots, gloves, hose, and ball.



Leather & cloth products

Bag and belt, etc. Cloth products that cannot be recycled such as stuffed toy Check page 13 about reusable clothes.

Wooden furniture & bedding products

You may take it out on Burnable garbage day for wooden furniture or futon bedding products, if it fits in the designated burnable garbage bag.

 \rightarrow The products which does not fit in the bag, take it out on Bulky garbage.

→Spring mattress take it out on [Metal garbage day].

→Reclining function chair take it out on [Metal garbage day].

Togari Cleaning Center uses heat from incineration to generate enough electricity to power 10,000 homes for a year. After incineration, the ashes are used as raw materials for asphalt.

Plastic containers & packaging

Designated garbage bag: written in black letters Collection location: separate garbage stations or recycle stations

What is plastic containers & packaging?

Egg plastic pack, cleaned cup noodle container, food tray, disposable plastic shopping bag, plastic containers, plastic wrapper or packaging, and plastic containers that are no longer needed after goods are consumed or separated.



Collected plastic is recycled into pallets, wheel chocks and manholes.

Glass products, beverage cans, pet bottles,Hazardous waste Dangerous waste

Glass bottles (for food and drink or cosmetic bottles)

1 sho bottle (1.8L), beer bottle, for food and beverages (e.g. seaweed, juice, edible oil, jam, alcohol, medicines bottles, etc.), and cosmetic bottles.

Take off caps (metal caps dispose on Metal garbage day, plastic caps dispose on Plastic garbage day.)

- Rinse the inside of items before dispose it (bottle of edible oil little remain is okay).
- Broken glass bottle dispose on Landfill garbage day.
- •Label or a metal cap that doesn't come off dispose it as is.
- Items sold only by bin bottle dispose it on Landfill garbage day.

The milky white color cosmetic bottle cannot be recycled, so please take it out on **Landfill** garbage day.



Glass bottle is recycled as construction and civil engineering materials.

Hazardous waste

Fluorescent lamps (not broken ones), rechargeable battery, battery, button type battery (including mercury free used type), clinical thermometer (mercury type), and mobile battery, Rechargeable appliances.

- Dispose fluorescent lamps or clinical thermometer without breaking them. (Broken items dispose it on Landfill garbage day.)
- For clinical thermometer item put in the case or sealed it before dispose.
- LED fluorescent lamps, LED electric light bulb, electronic thermometer dispose it on Metal garbage day.
- Electric light bulb and broken fluorescent lamps dispose it on **Landfill garbage** day.
- Small size rechargeable appliance (less than 30cm on one side) whose batteries cannot be removed.
- Appliances whose batteries were removed.

Dangerous waste

Gas lighter, Spray cans, Cassette cylinder

The product that has Caution description label of fire and high

- temperature 「火気と高温に注意」must take it out on Dangerous waste day. Use up the contents before dispose it.
- No need to open a hole. (Dispose the punched spray cans as dangerous waste as well.)
 - Carbon dioxide cartridge dispose on Metal garbage day.

Please be sure to separate garbage items correctly and properly because when mistakenly placed, it may cause of disposal facility fire disaster or machine will break down while disposing it.

Please choose the following method 1 or 2 for recycling the items.

1 Request home appliance retailer or electronics retail store for picking up.

Please consult home appliance retailer or electronics retail store to check the price etc. and request for picking up. Some retailers or stores visit individual house for pickup. Price includes recycle fee (%1).

①Discarding an electric appliance due to its replacing:

Request the store where you will purchase the new appliance to forward the old appliance for recycling. The store must accept the old appliance recycling.

To discard an electric appliance:

- Request the store where you purchases the appliance to forward it for recycling. The store where you purchased it must accept the old appliance recycling.
- If the store where you purchased the appliance has closed, you may ask in other electric retailers if 4 electric appliances' recycling is available. Please check Toyota City Hall for further details.

2 Bring items directly to designated place.

(Attach the recycle tag(%2) on each item in advance.) Please check opening hours at each company.

Harmful substances are included to some of products in 4 items of home electrical appliances. Please don't take apart and follow above instructions in order to disposal garbages appropriately Do not use unauthorized garbage collectors. Usually, these self-called recyclers pick up used appliances at home or receive them at vacant lots.

Disposal of fire extinguishers Fire extinguisher makers, etc. collect and recycle them in safety.

Handle fire extinguishers in any of the following methods.

1 Ask the designated contact point. Call any of the following designated contact points

Ask the charge, etc. on the phone or by any other means and determine if you bring the fire extinguishers to the designated collection place or ask for home pick-up. You need to pay the charge for recycle stickers and transportation/storage (the amount differs depending on the designated contact point).

How to disposal of bulky garbage

Large items that cannot fit designated garbage bags are considered Bulky Garbage. Bulky garbage collection service picks it in front of you home (1st floor, if apartment building)
