Bus Instructions

- 1** Before riding the bus, please check the destination indicated on the display panel on the front or door side of the bus.
- 2** Board the bus through the back door.
- 3** [When using cash] Please get the number-printed ticket from the ticketing machine. [When using an IC card] Please scan your IC card on the reader at the entrance until it makes a sound, then take your seat.
- 4** Please push the button after the announcement of the bus stop you intend to get off.
- 5** The bus fare depends on the distance you traveled. To find your fare, match the number on your ticket with the one displayed on the electronic monitor. Please use the money-changing machine next to the driver in advance to make change for your exact fare.
- 6** [When using cash] Please drop your number-printed ticket and cash into the fare box next to the driver. [When using an IC card] Please scan your IC card on the reader next to the driver. Fares will be automatically calculated and deducted from the balance on the card.
- 7** Please exit the bus through the front door.

Korankei Gorge

Directions: Bus: Toyotashi Station (Meitetsu Bus Yanami route) → Get off at Korankei (about 45 minutes)

Description: Korankei, where about 4,000 maple trees have been planted, offers spectacular fall scenery from early to late November. Additionally, dogtooth violets grow in bunches from mid-March to early April, and the trees are aglow with fresh new leaves from mid-April to mid-May - a rejuvenating place to visit during any season.

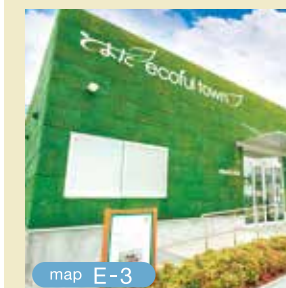

Description: This event, Toyota's largest civic festival, takes advantage of the individuality of each part of the city. It consists of My Town Oiden, which is put on entirely by the locals; the Oiden So'odori, a lively dance that takes place in the central part of the city, and a fireworks display that is one of Japan's very best.
