## Notice Regarding the Mailing of National Health Insurance Eligibility Notification

National Health Insurance Eligibility Notification (hereinafter referred to as “Eligibility Notification”) is being mailed to individuals **who have a My Number Card with registered health insurance functionality** (referred to as a “**Myna Health Insurance Card**”) as of May 31, 2025. Please continue to use your Myna Health Insurance Card when receiving medical services.

Please make sure to securely dispose of your old National Health Insurance Card or Eligibility Certificate. Take appropriate measures to protect your personal information during the disposal process.

### Important Notice: Discontinuation of the Certificate of National Health Insurance Co-payment Rate for the Elderly [*Korei Jukyushasho*] (For individuals aged 70 and over)

The Eligibility Notification being sent includes the co-payment rate and other benefit details that were previously shown on the certificate that is being replaced.

Please keep this notification together with your Myna Health Insurance Card.

### Important information

① **Please keep your Eligibility Notification together with your Myna Health Insurance Card**

In the event that a card reader at a medical institution is unable to read your card due to a malfunction or other issue, the Eligibility Notification—which contains key insurance information—can be used as a backup for verification.

② **② If you are currently enrolled in Employee Health Insurance [*Shakai Hoken*] or another health insurance program, please complete the procedure to withdraw from the National Health Insurance**

You may complete the withdrawal process through one of the following methods:

- Online (via the electronic application)
- By mail
- In person at the division in charge

③ **③ Please pay your National Health Insurance tax by the due date**

Failure to pay your National Health Insurance tax without a valid reason may result in a requirement to pay the full cost of medical services out of pocket. This action will be taken after prior notice.

### Additional information

① Please note that the expiration date may vary for individuals turning 75 by July 31, 2026, as well as for foreign nationals.

② Renewal notices for the Certificate for Application of the Maximum Copayment Amount [*Gendogaku Tekiyo Ninteisho*] will no longer be sent. As your co-payment limit information is now automatically integrated with your Myna Health Insurance Card, it is no longer necessary to carry the certificate. Renewal procedures are also no longer required.
